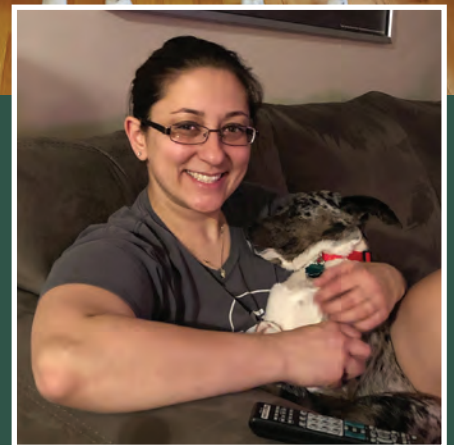
my home + pets

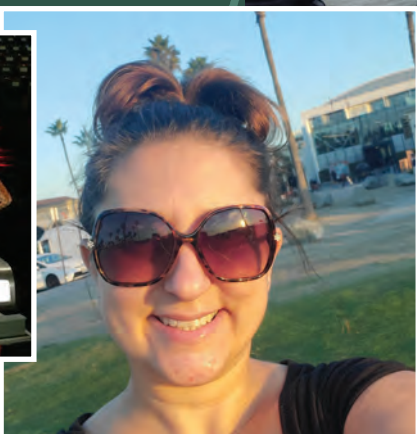
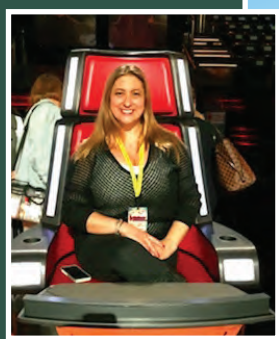
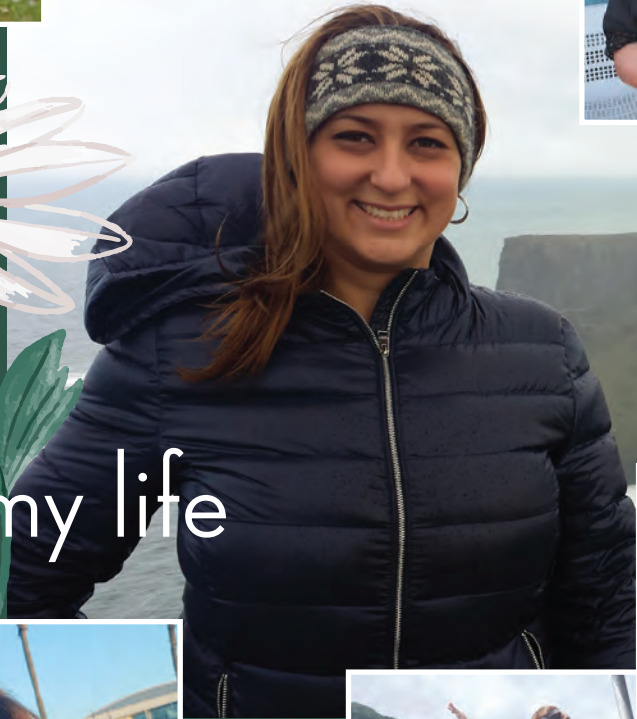
what led me to adoption

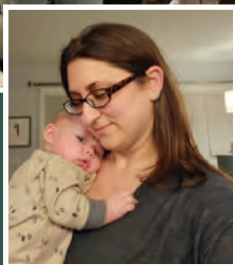
