OUR HOME & PETS

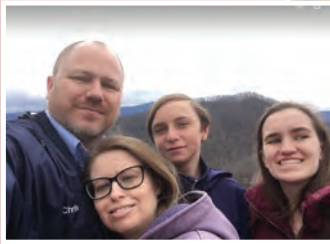
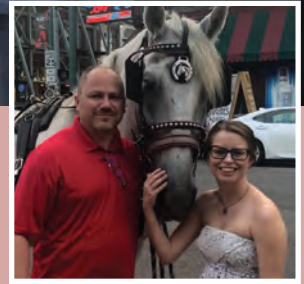
