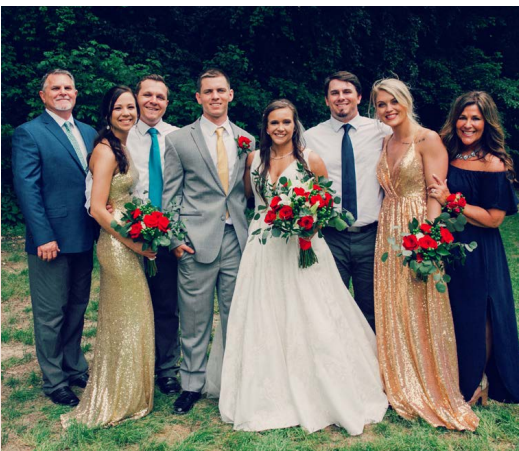


OUR FAMILIES
