about us



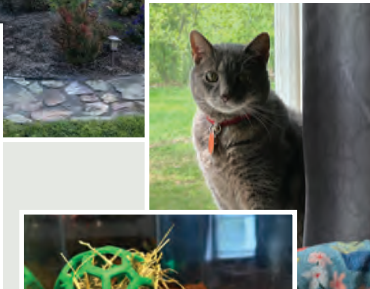
