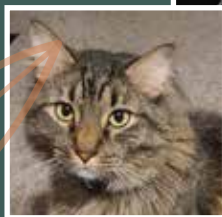
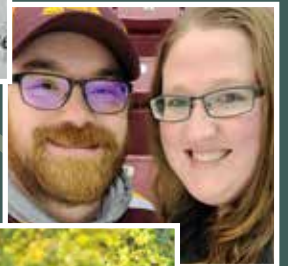
OUR LIFESTYLE
