## our home &

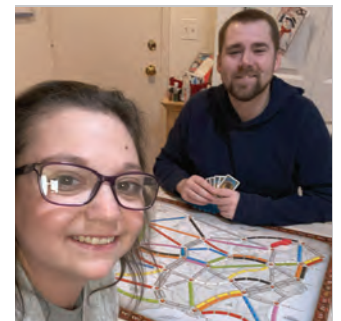
