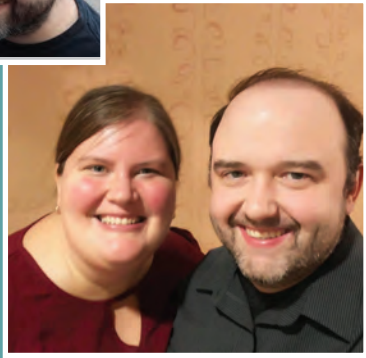
Our home + pets

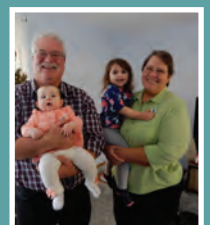
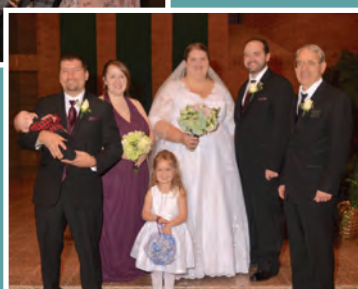
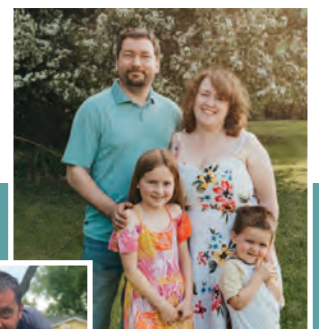
our family *and* traditions
