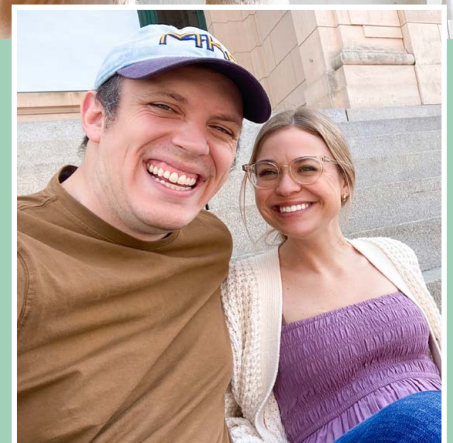
our home + pet

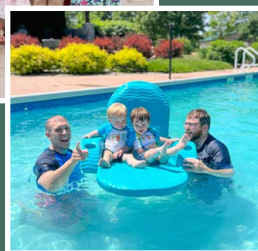
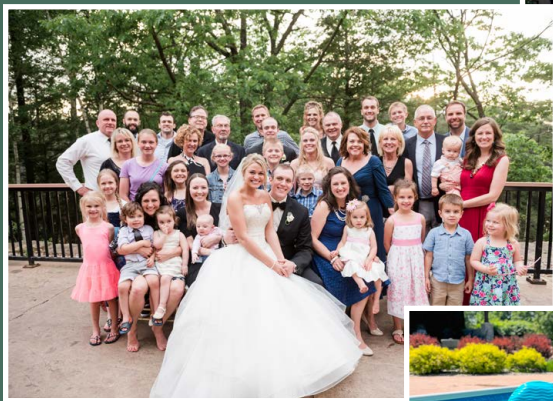
our family + traditions
