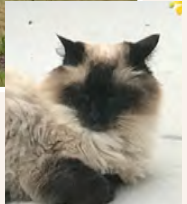
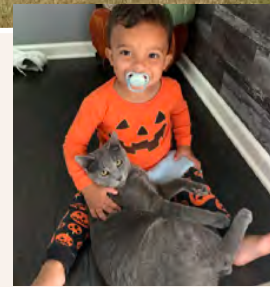
ABOUT US

OUR HOME & PETS

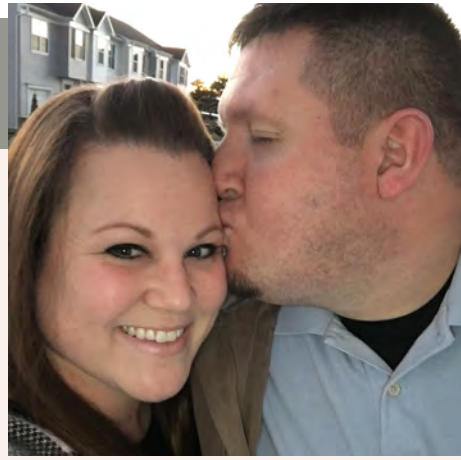

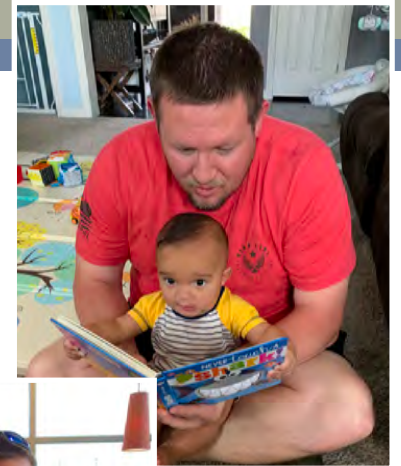

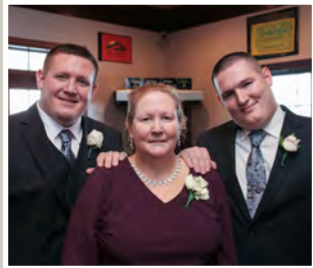
