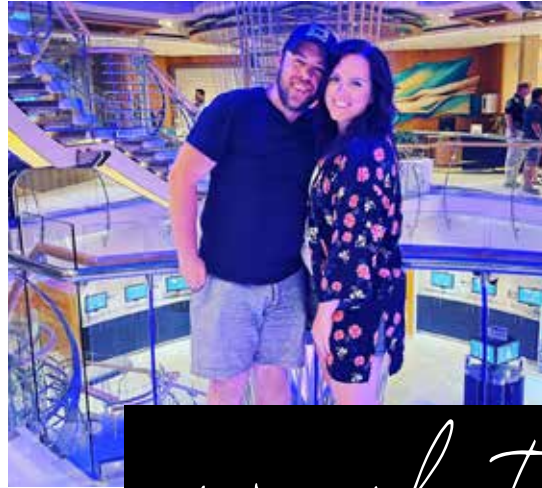
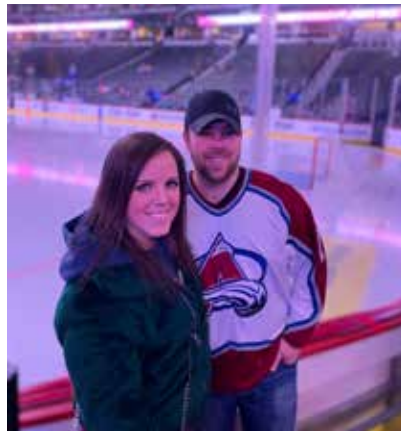


OUR HOME & PETS

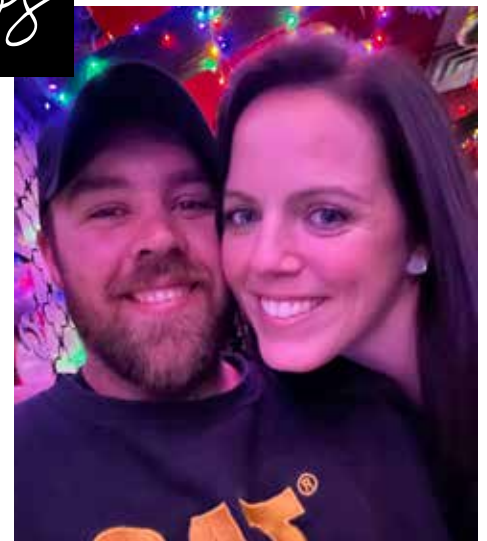
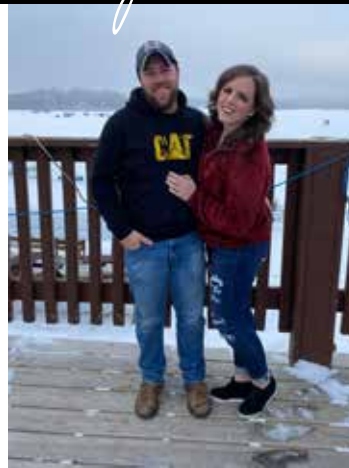

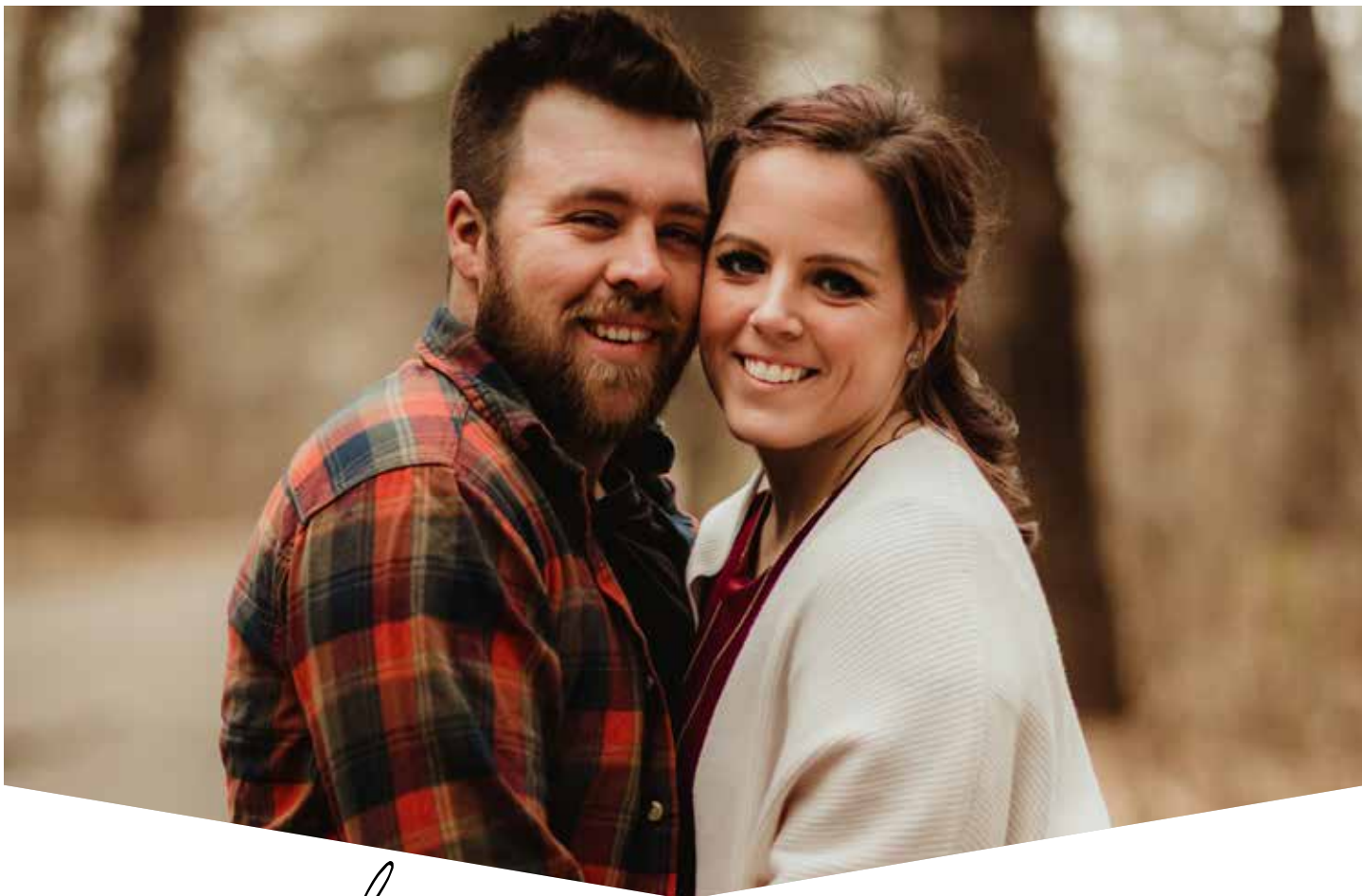
OUR FAMILY
