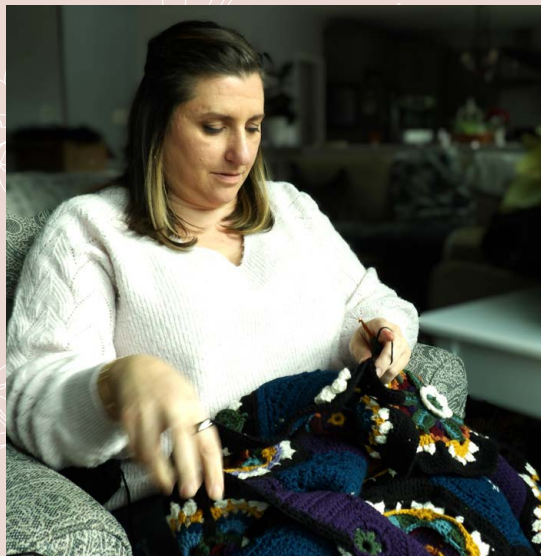
MY HOME + PETS
