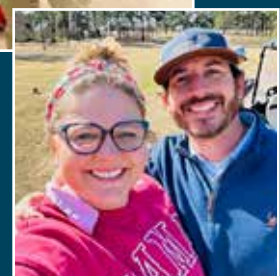
OUR HOME & PETS

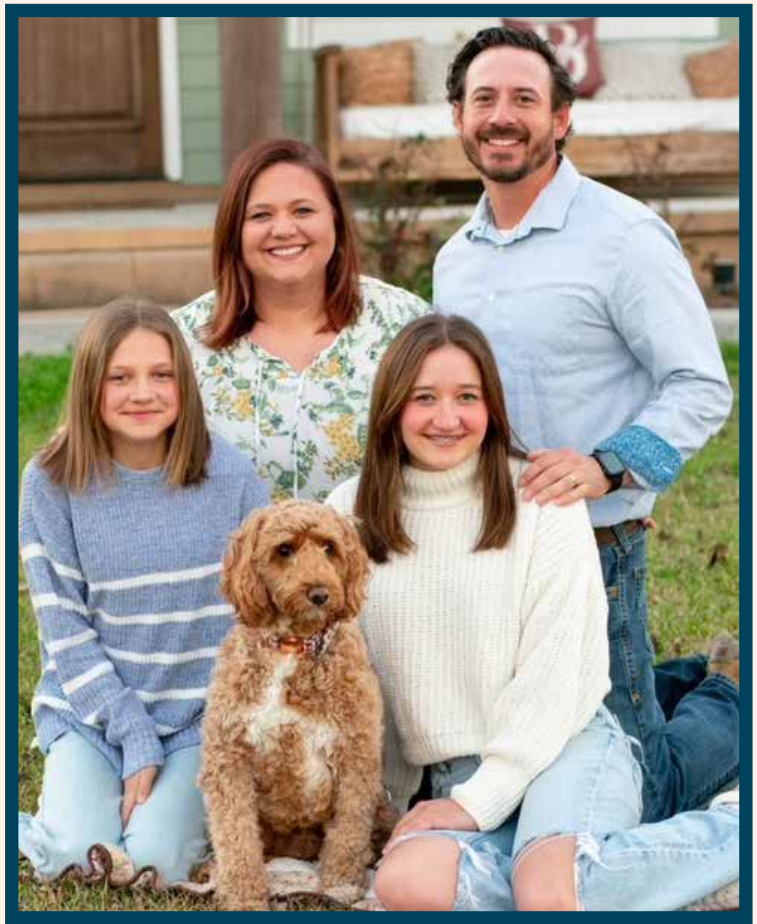
OUR FAMILY + traditions
