I frequently visit local gardens, the zoo, and the aquarium with my goddaughter.

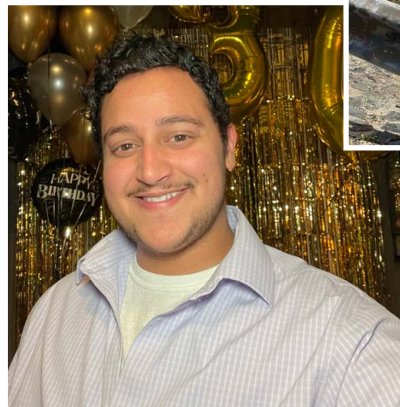
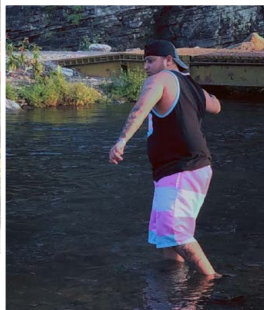
MY HOME + PETS

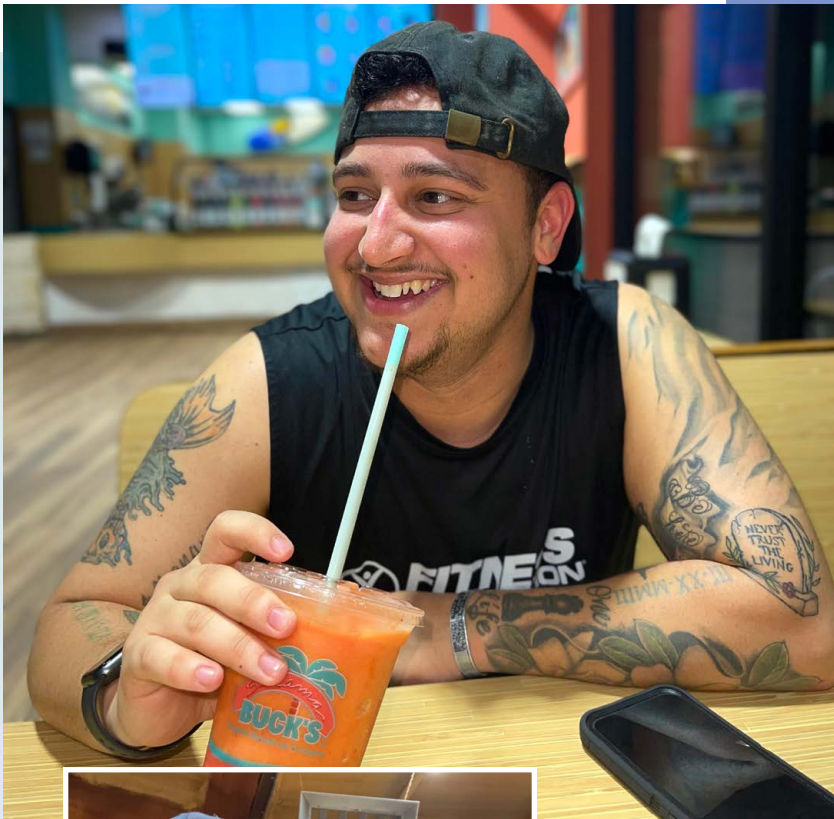

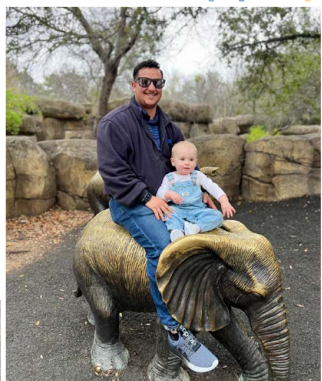
