OUR HOME

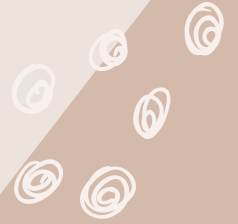

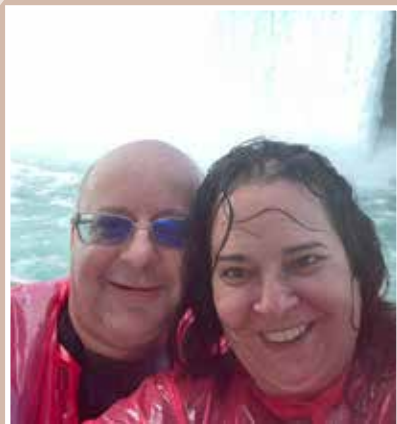
WHAT LED US TO ADOPTION

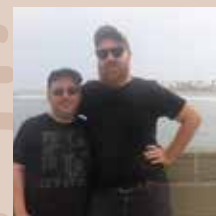
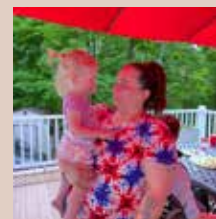
