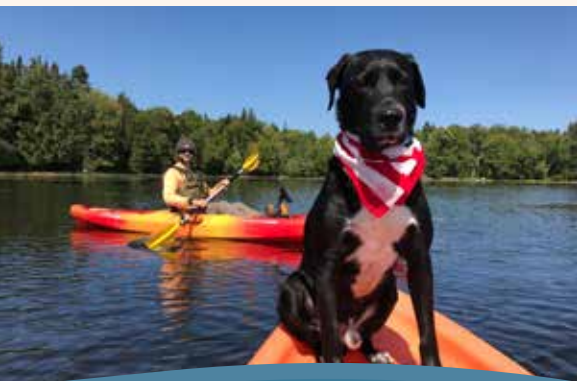

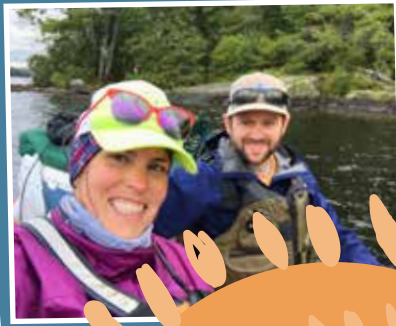


ADOPTION IN OUR LIVES
