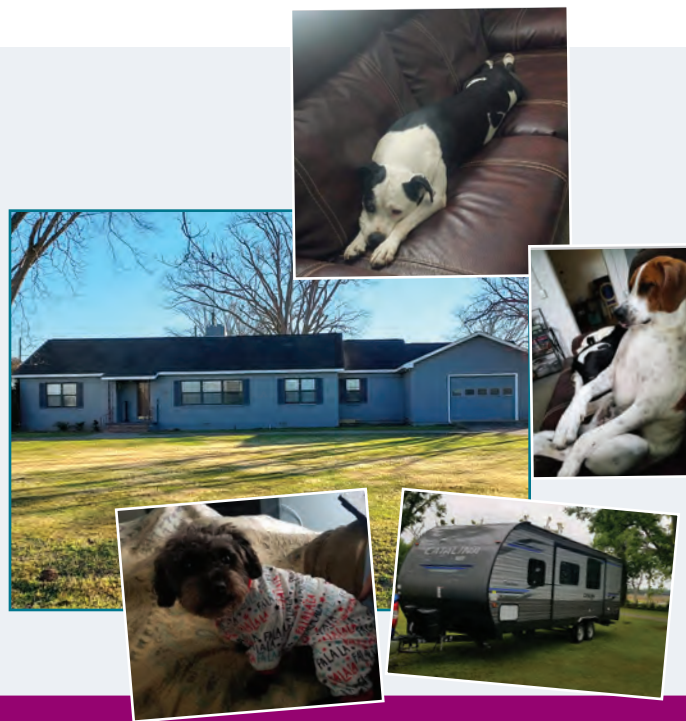
ABOUT US

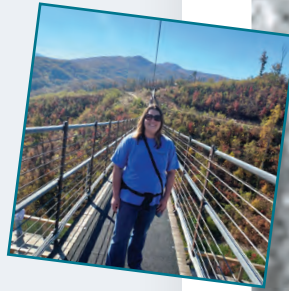
