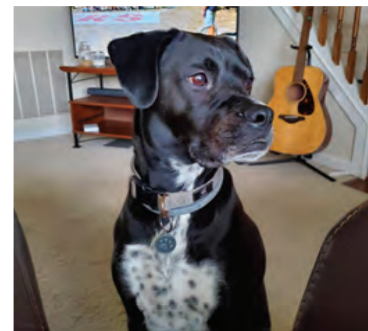


ABOUT ME
