## OUR HOME & PETS ❤️

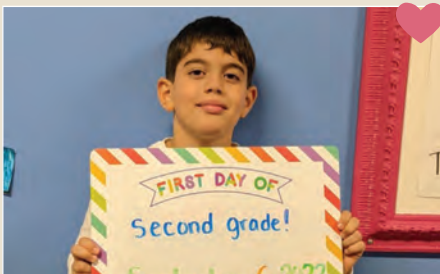
