OUR HOME

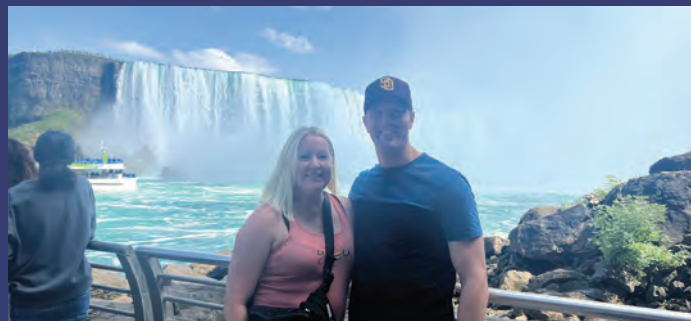
