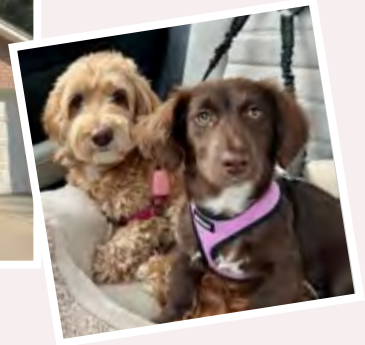

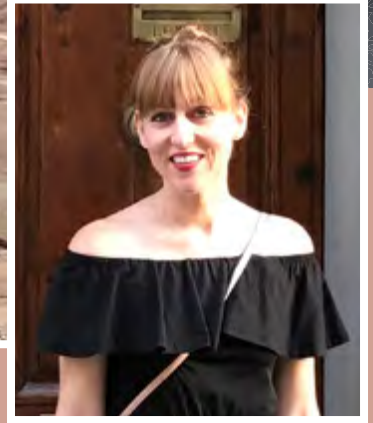
OUR HOME & PETS
