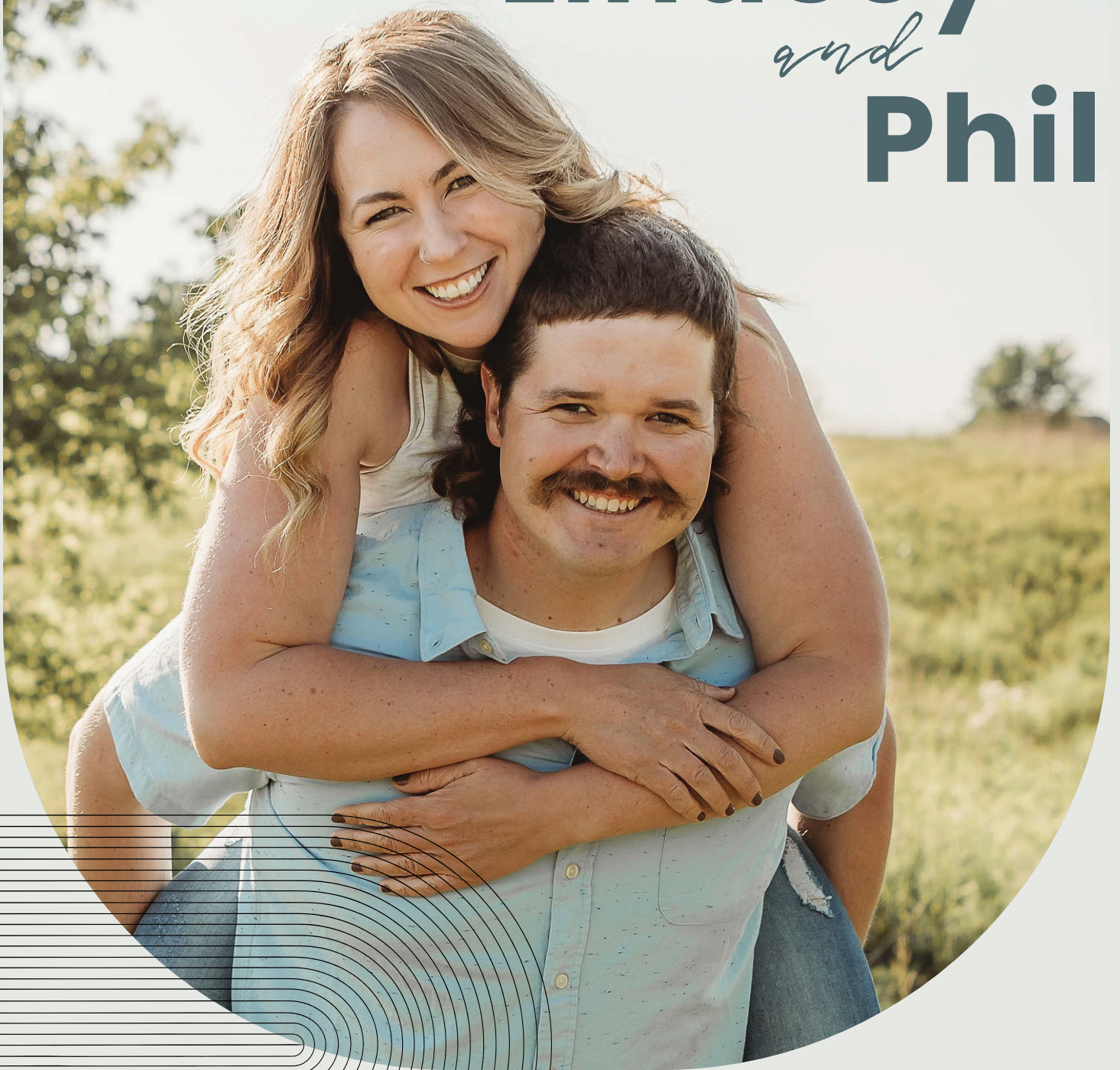

## *our home and pets*

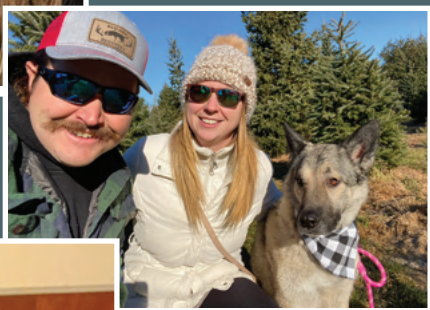
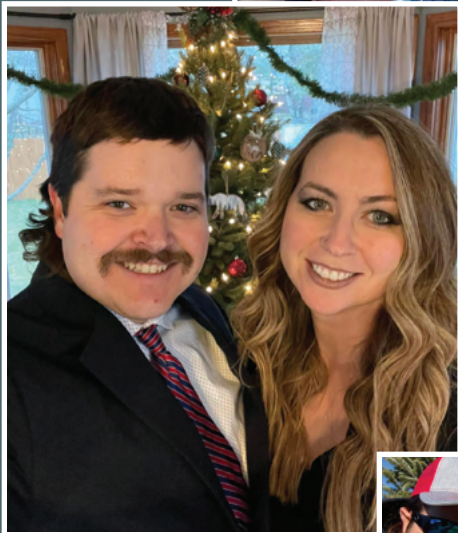

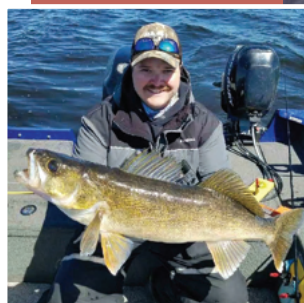
