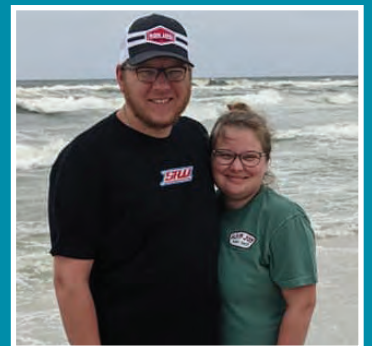
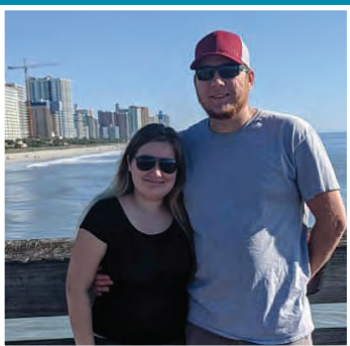
WHAT LED US TO ADOPTION

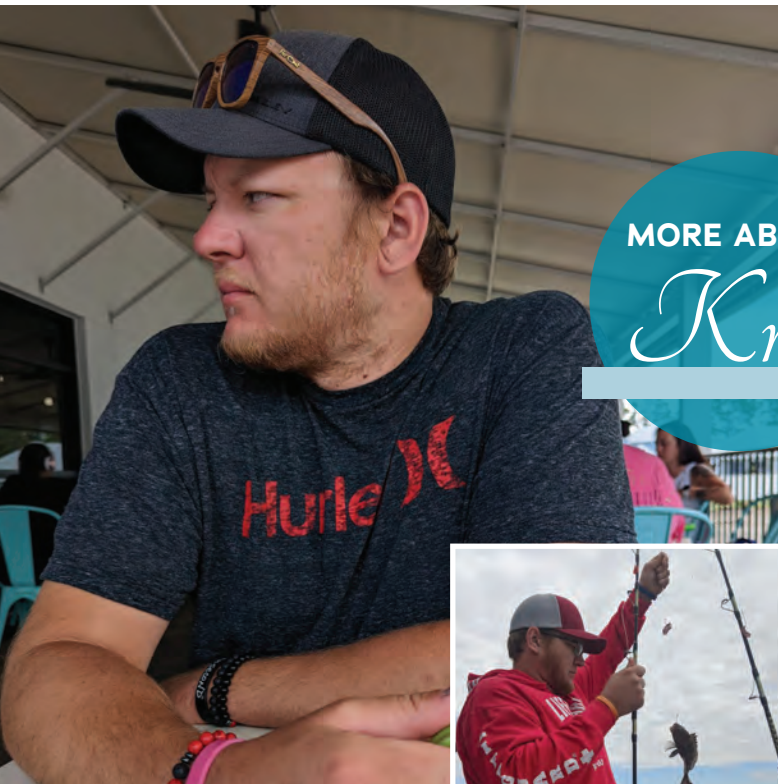

FAMILY FUN



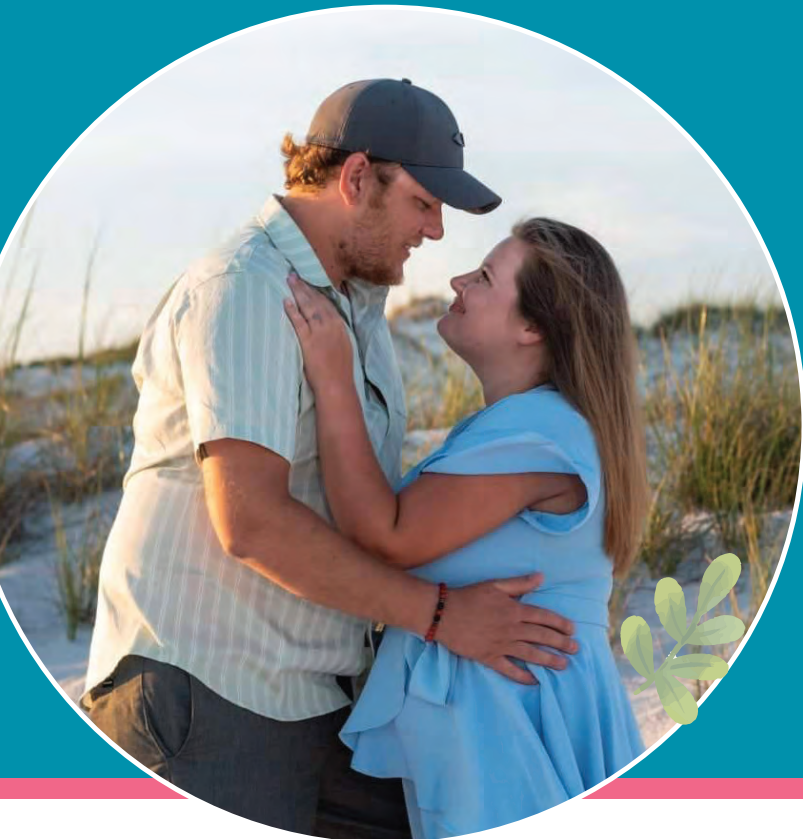
OUR FAMILY + traditions
