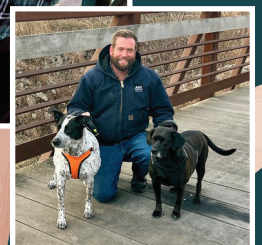
OUR FAMILY & friends
