OUR HOME

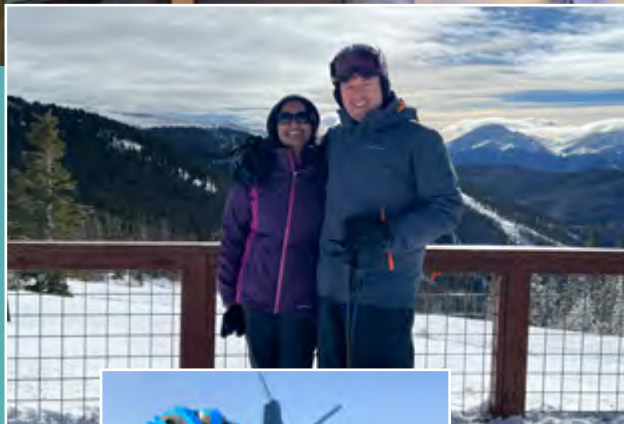
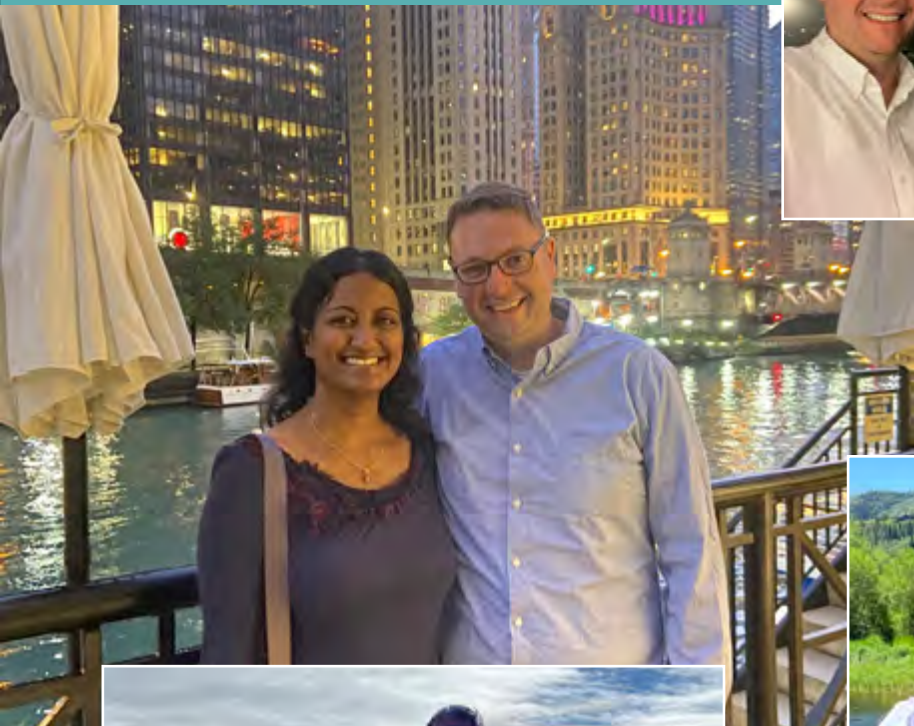
