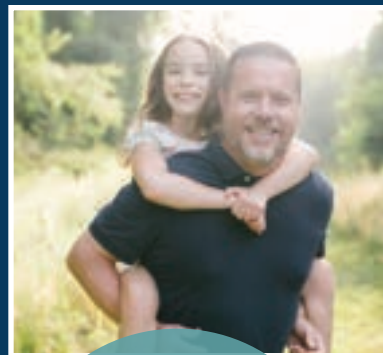

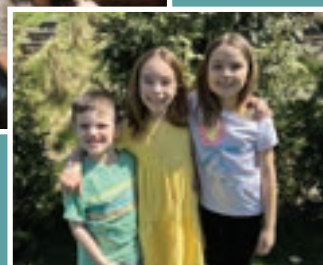


our family *and* traditions
