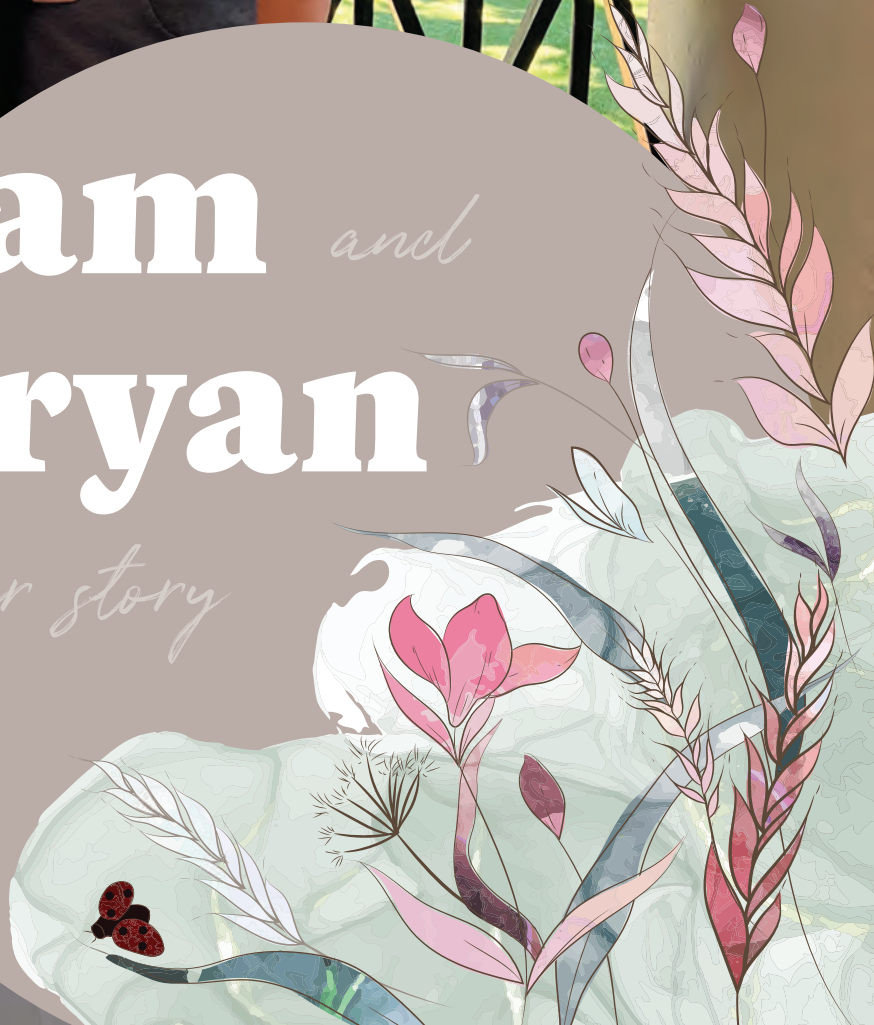

about us

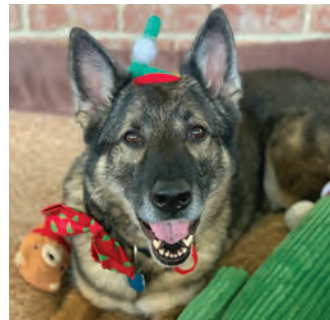
