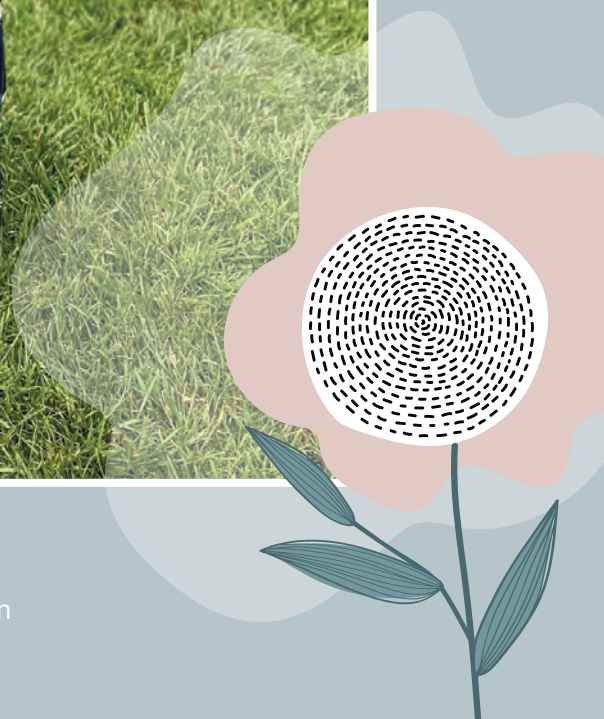


Andy and Erin

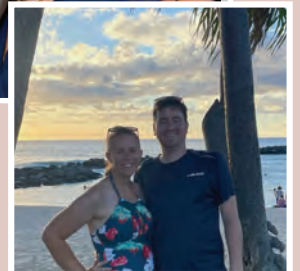
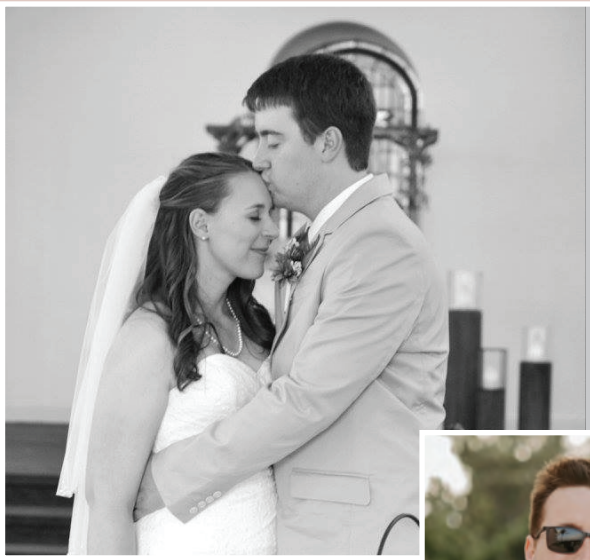


WHAT LED US TO ADOPTION
