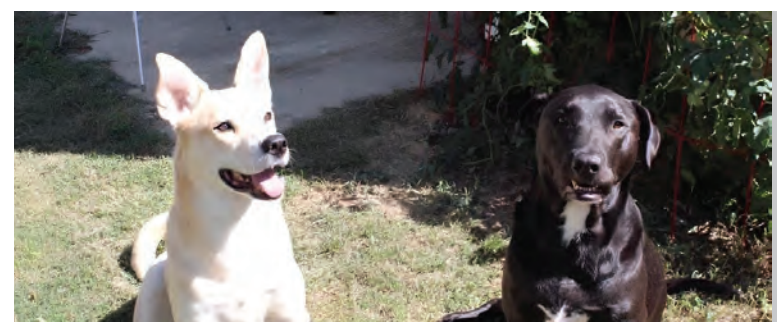

## OUR HOME & PETS

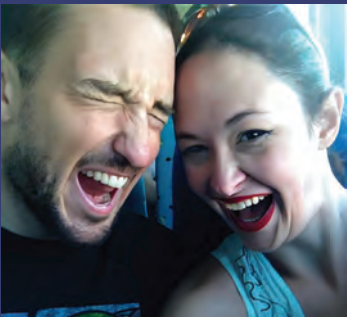
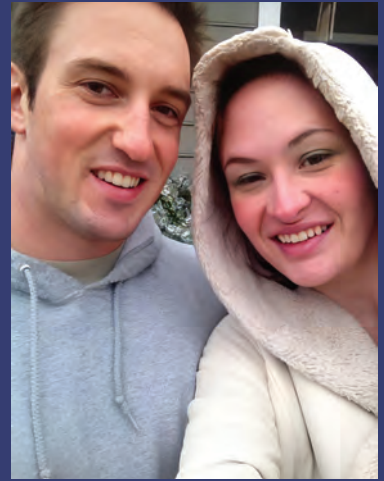
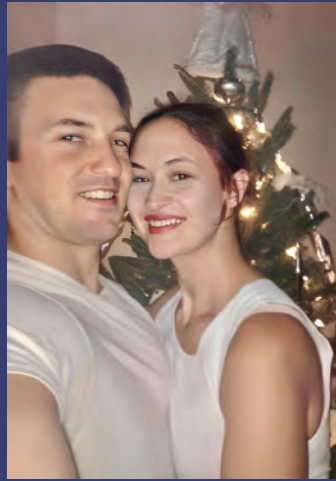

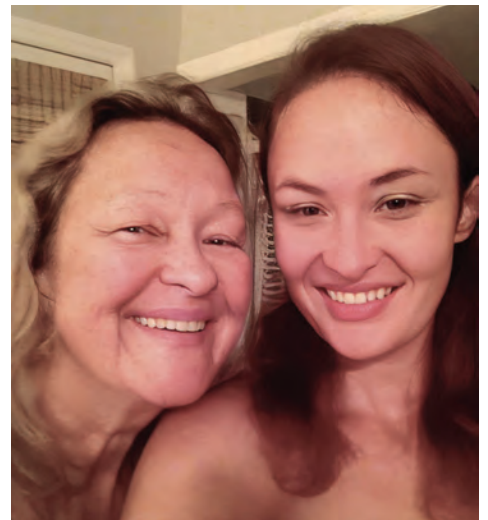
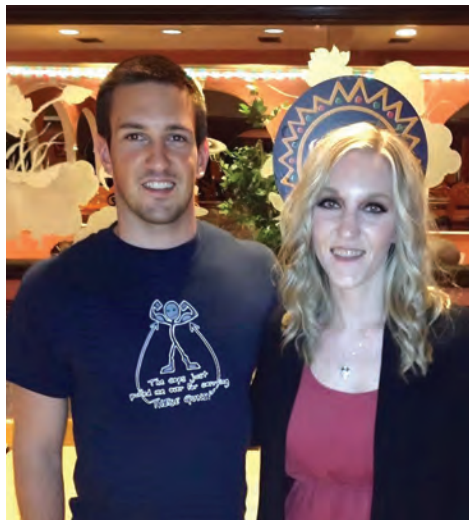




## OUR FAMILY & TRADITIONS
