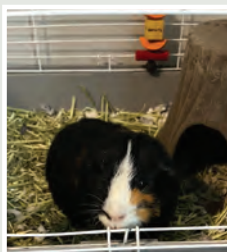
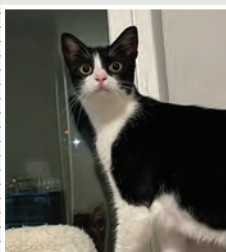


our home and pets

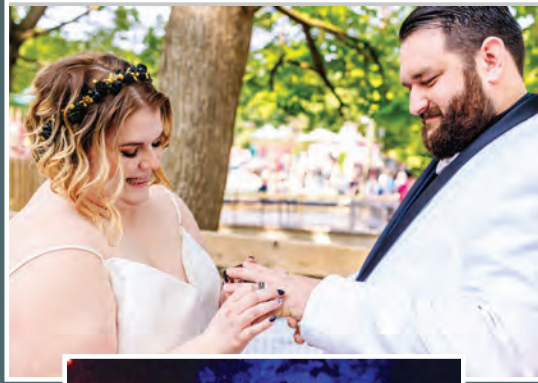
