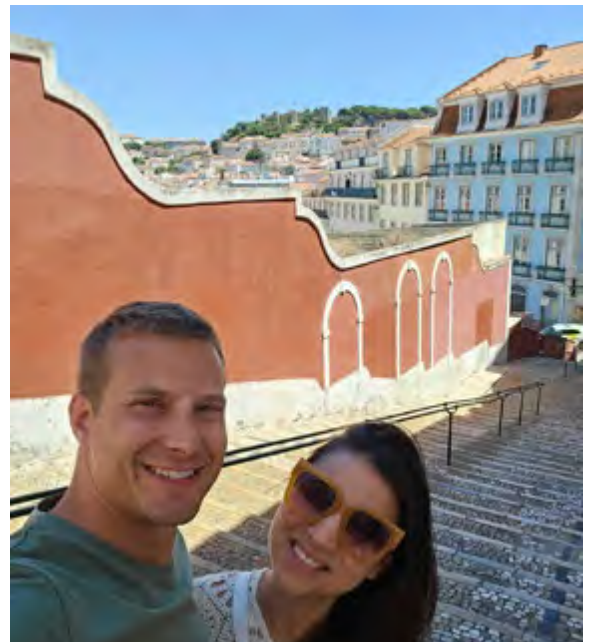


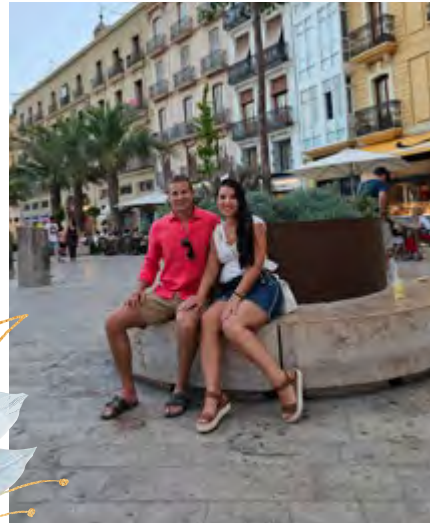
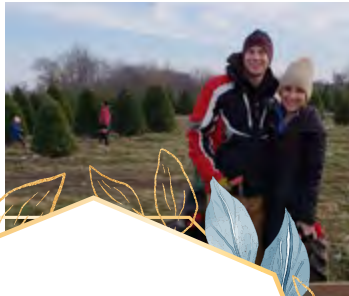
Our home & pet

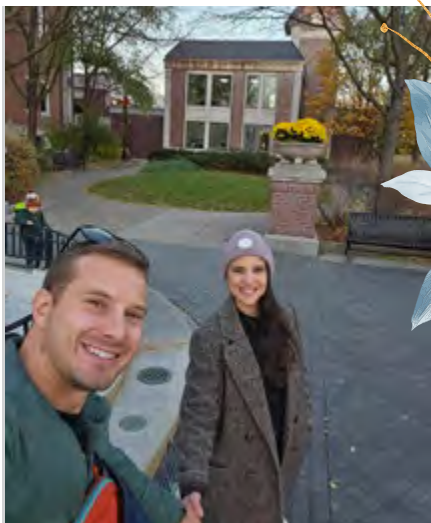
What led us to adoption

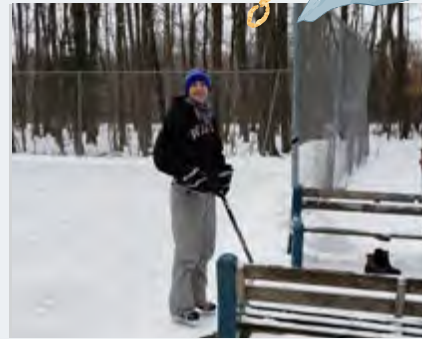

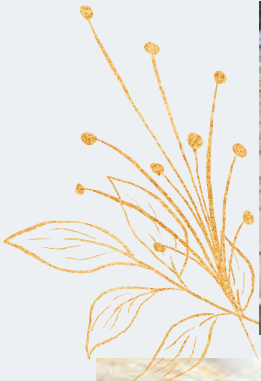

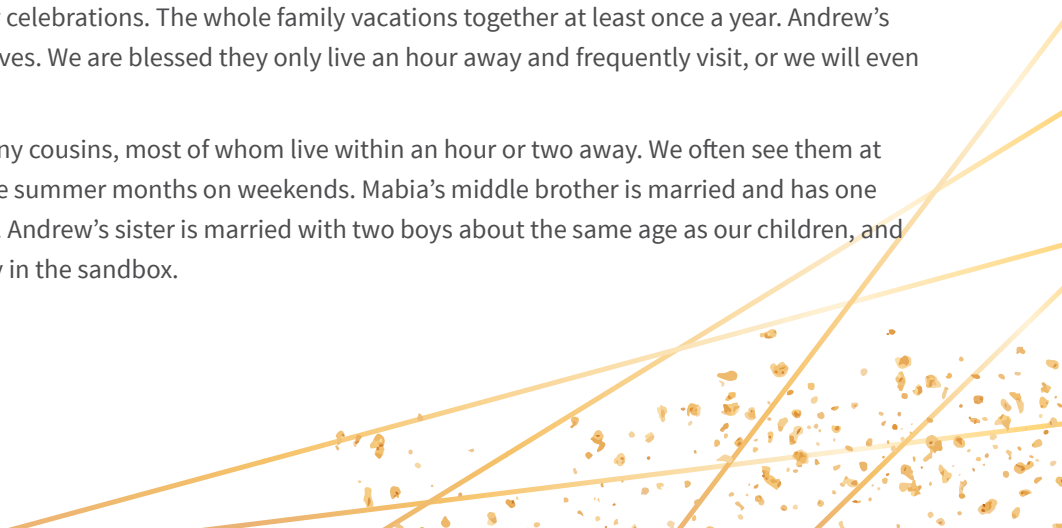
our family *and* traditions
