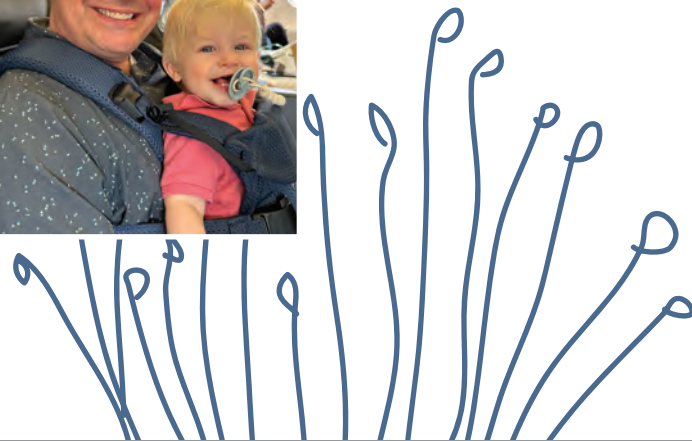

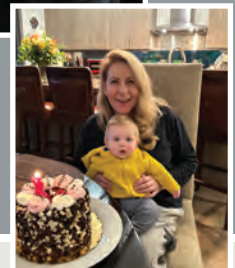


OUR FAMILIES & FRIENDS
