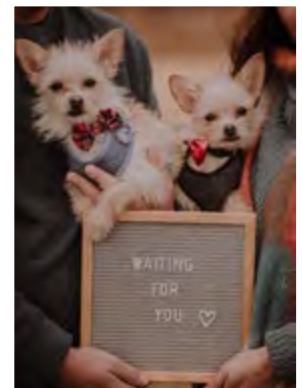


About us

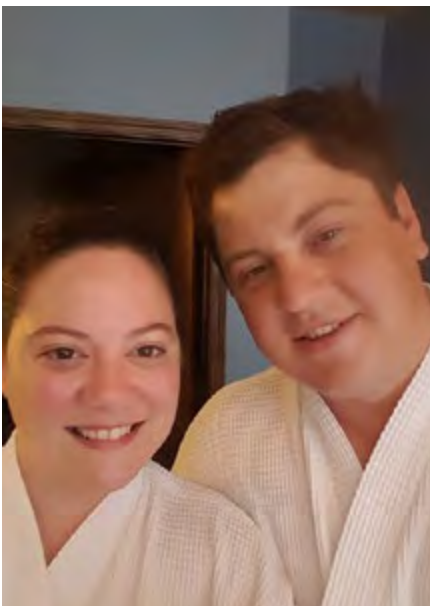
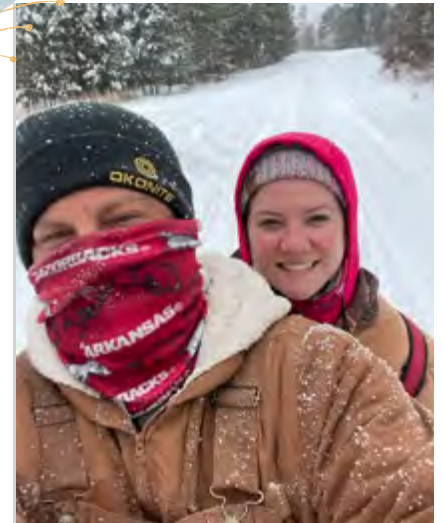
Our home & pets

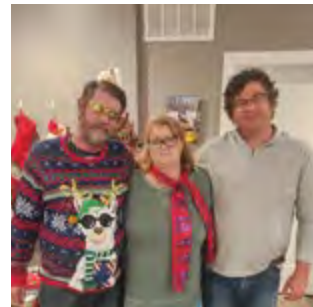

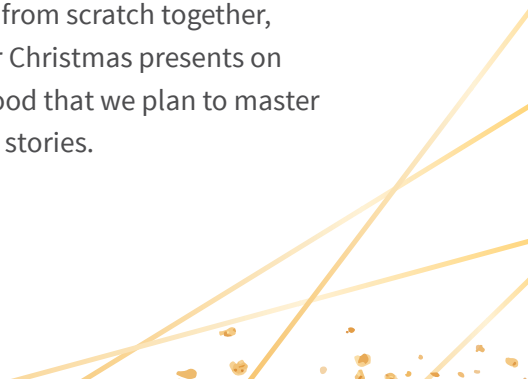
