MY HOME + PETS

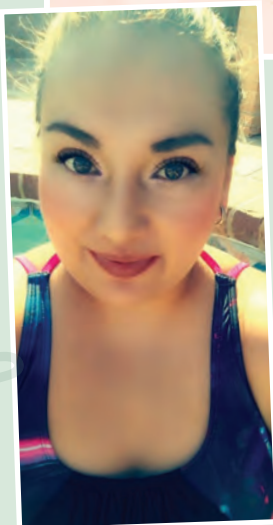
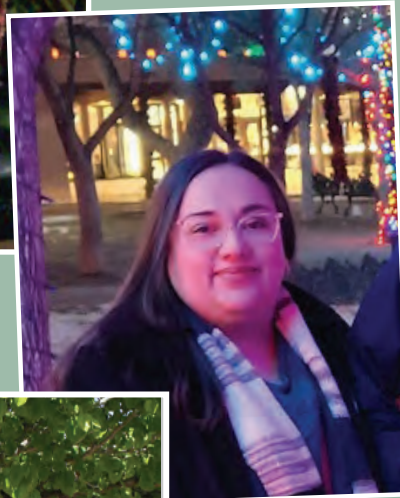

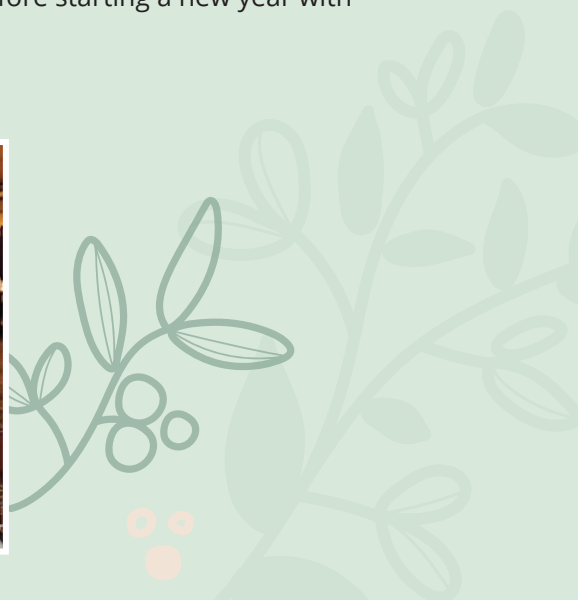
MY FAMILY + TRADITIONS
