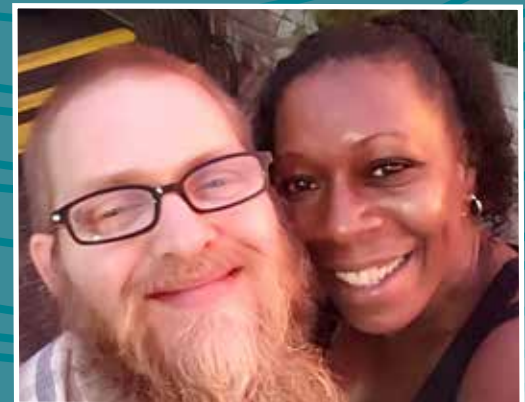
our home & pets

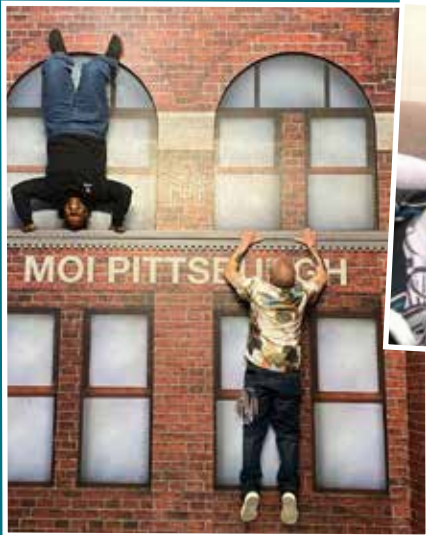
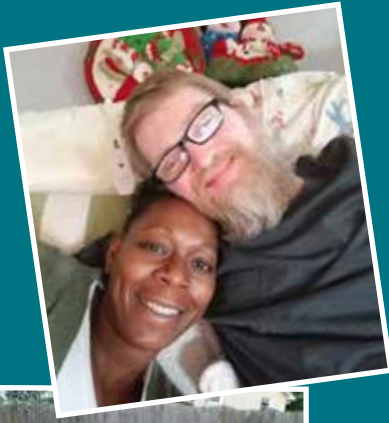
WHAT LED US TO ADOPTION
