OUR HOME & PETS

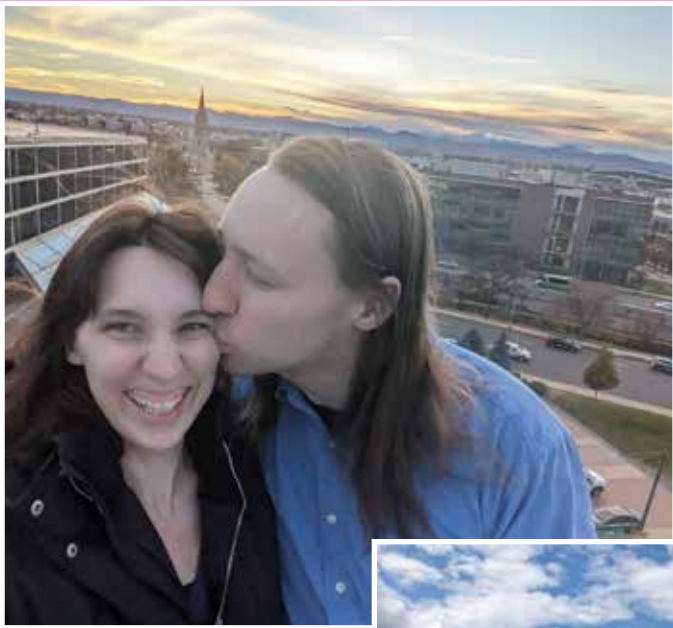
