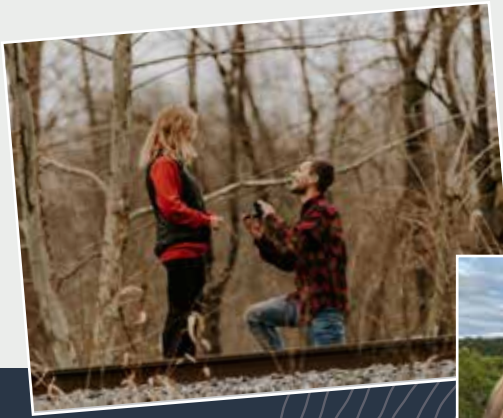
OUR HOME + PETS

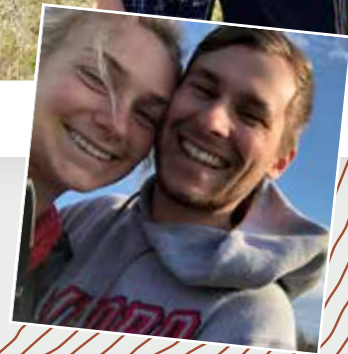
