MY HOME + PETS

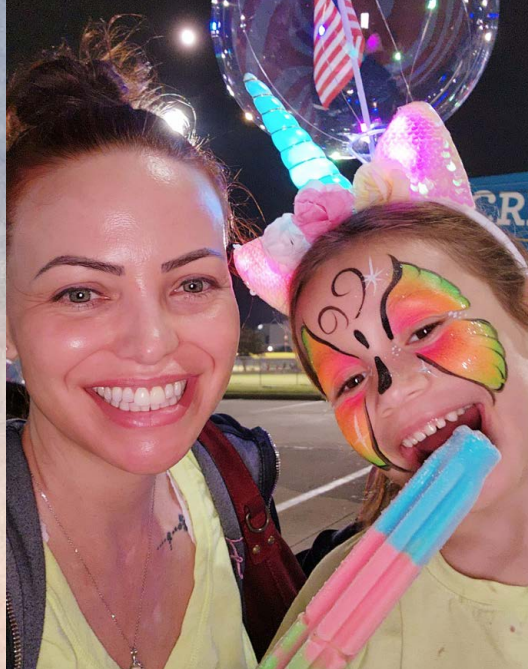
